



Accounting Doctoral Scholars Program Participating Universities Criteria and Selection

While the selection of universities to be invited to participate in the Accounting Doctoral Scholars Program involves some subjectivity, generally the following criteria will be used.

The principal criteria are:

1. Statement of available capacity to support one or more incremental slots for doctoral students with a focus in auditing or tax;
2. Strong placement potential at universities that produce substantial numbers of accounting graduates for the public accounting profession;
3. Full-time and residential program; and
4. Business school is AACSB International accredited.

Other factors considered are:

1. Number of doctoral graduates in accounting produced over most recent four years;
2. Record of interaction of program and faculty with the accounting profession.
